

Antigonish April 29th 1857

Mr James Dawson

Dear Sir

I am sorry to have to trouble you with a complaint about the News of Churches Mr Daniel Fraser Blacksmith South River & Mr William Chisholm Sattspring, have not received their numbers for March & April and are dissatisfied I am sorry that anything should have been wrong with Chisholm as he got only the 3 last numbers for his $\frac{3}{4}$ last year and I had promised to get him all the back numbers

I sent your notes to Messrs Hill and Boyd I called on them to-day on purpose Hill promised to have it in a few days but he is not much to be depended on, Boyd has promised his as soon as the school money is divided as he has ~~to~~ some to draw from some of the Teachers he can depend on and it is generally drawn about the

1st of May I will watch the time
and if he disappoints me now I will
get a new execution out and have
property sold

You will please to attend to these re-
marks about the News of the Churches

You did not mention when you
intend to leave Pictou I am sorry
you are going to leave us but I sup-
pose every thing is for the best in some
way
