Victoria 24th Nov^r 1858

Dear Christian friend

Your much
esteemed favor of the 1st Nov^r was received
on the 15th inclosing a 20/ Note
Allow me to return you Money thanks
for this handsome Seasonable Donation
for alleviating the Sufferings of the
Poor in Victoria. In Promose Esq kindly
changed the Note of the first I purchased
3/ worth of tracts English and Galicia
including one Copy of J A James' Asseaus
enquerer in Galicia for the purpose of lend-
ing out. I have marked them all to be
returned when read and exchanged
This will be food for the Soul through the
Winter. Already ten very poor families
Mostly Widows have received (or will shortly)
a little temporary relief for which they
appear in most cases truly grateful
The Balance which I have reserved will
most likely be spent on a bushell of coal
new and then by and by.

I observe what you state about the

Bureau Society you Patronize I wish
them all Success Long may you
have enough and to spare for one
and all of them

I thank you for your kind remem-
brance of Friends here at a throne
I particularly ^{have} an interest in your prayers
for all the Churches in Piton Pastors
and people that there may be
an Abundant outpouring of ^{the} Holy Spirit
in the midst of them a time of
reviving and refreshing from the
presence of the Lord

Please present my respectful Compliments
to Mr & Mrs W Dawson and much
Love to there dear children wishing
you all every blessing both temporal
and Spiritual
