I think your Dad was just the nicest person to give you \$5 - because it must have been quite expensive for you coming to Montreal -

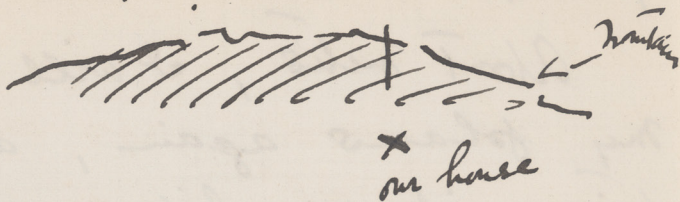
I am so glad you made \$400. so soon after returning, it

lost) —

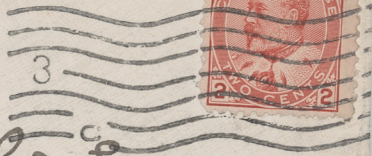
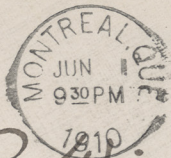
Thank you for the car tickets
