

Harrington, and consists of a series of interesting sketches from the West. There is also a flag from Dawson City, presented by William Bell Dawson. In addition to these, there has recently come to light a wonderful old picture of Sir William and Lady Dawson and their children, taken on the steps of the Principal's Residence approximately 1865.
