No a Neuropteris hirsuta Desf.
Probably the species, but upper
level of leaf a few scattered
of obscure leaflets

No b Calamites — probably
C. Suckowii, Brong.

10e Lepidodendron Terranovicum
US. Newnankulle species with
some features resembling Sigillaria
In old stems the leaf-bases
vertically disposed resembling
ribs. (Will prepare description)

10d. Recopteris abbreviata Brongt

10e Neuropteris rarineris Brongt
Conelaites braueri, Brongt

11 Leaves of Lepidodendron
& Sigillaria.

12. Roots of Annularia?
In same soil as Udohia
Randolpha,

12 a Receptetis — allied
to P. athyroides, Bnpt, but
venation same.

12 b Stipnaria — possibly
but of Siphonodonta rather
than of Sigillaria

12 c Colanites Sukovi? Bnpt
