As to veins of iron pyrites in the Limestone of Finch, I do not remember to have noticed anything on the subject in any of the publications of the Geol. Survey. However, I will enquire further & if I hear anything as to their occurrence will let you know.

Finch appears to be situated upon metamorphic rocks of the Trenton Group and it is therefore not likely that veins of iron pyrites of any importance occur there.
