My dear Dr Samson

I returned from

Cacouna last night and this morning
received your letter from ~~Montreal~~^{metis}

I was able to see Ouimé for a short
time, he says that Loly has abandoned
the change in the Educational System

running the government at present, objects
to do so. I am glad you have written
Synch; I will see him, this afternoon

Marriage License Money in Ottawa, I have
