The collection is a first duplicate of what is known as the "Philip Carpenter Collection" reserved by Dr. C. for his own private use & study. There is a rough catalogue accompanying it which shows it to contain over 4000 species. Each species is enclosed in a box together with its determination, and at present these are contained in a chest of drawers in a condition to be easily packed for carriage. Together with this collection is a duplicate of the "Masatlan collection" made by Dr C for the British Museum, who publish a catalogue which I believe is to be obtained from them for a few shillings. I would submit an offer of £150.00 but till I hear from Canada I cannot say if it would be accepted.
