It is a weary wait and
I often try to fancy where
you may be; and I must
confess sometimes with dead

you may be exposed. I can

of you is a very terrible one,
and leaves a void which
no one can fill.

I doubt if at this season
they will come out.

Our orders to Brittain
go by this mail, and are
expected to be put up for
the packet which leaves Liver-
pool July 14. Anything
therefore that you wish
to send should be out
at 8 o'clock by new post.
at thereabout. Do not send
anything bulky, as there
will very likely be great
difficulty in getting the
parcel overland. If you
have any quantity of things
to send to any person who
