Quebec March 11. 1873

Sir  
On receipt of my appointment as Naturalist  
to the Boundary Commission, I wrote to Hon<sup>ble</sup> J<sup>r</sup> Clark  
asking more detailed information on Seraponts;

communication with you.

necessary to join the Expedition, over what region  
of country the work is likely to extend during the  
 ensuing Summer.
