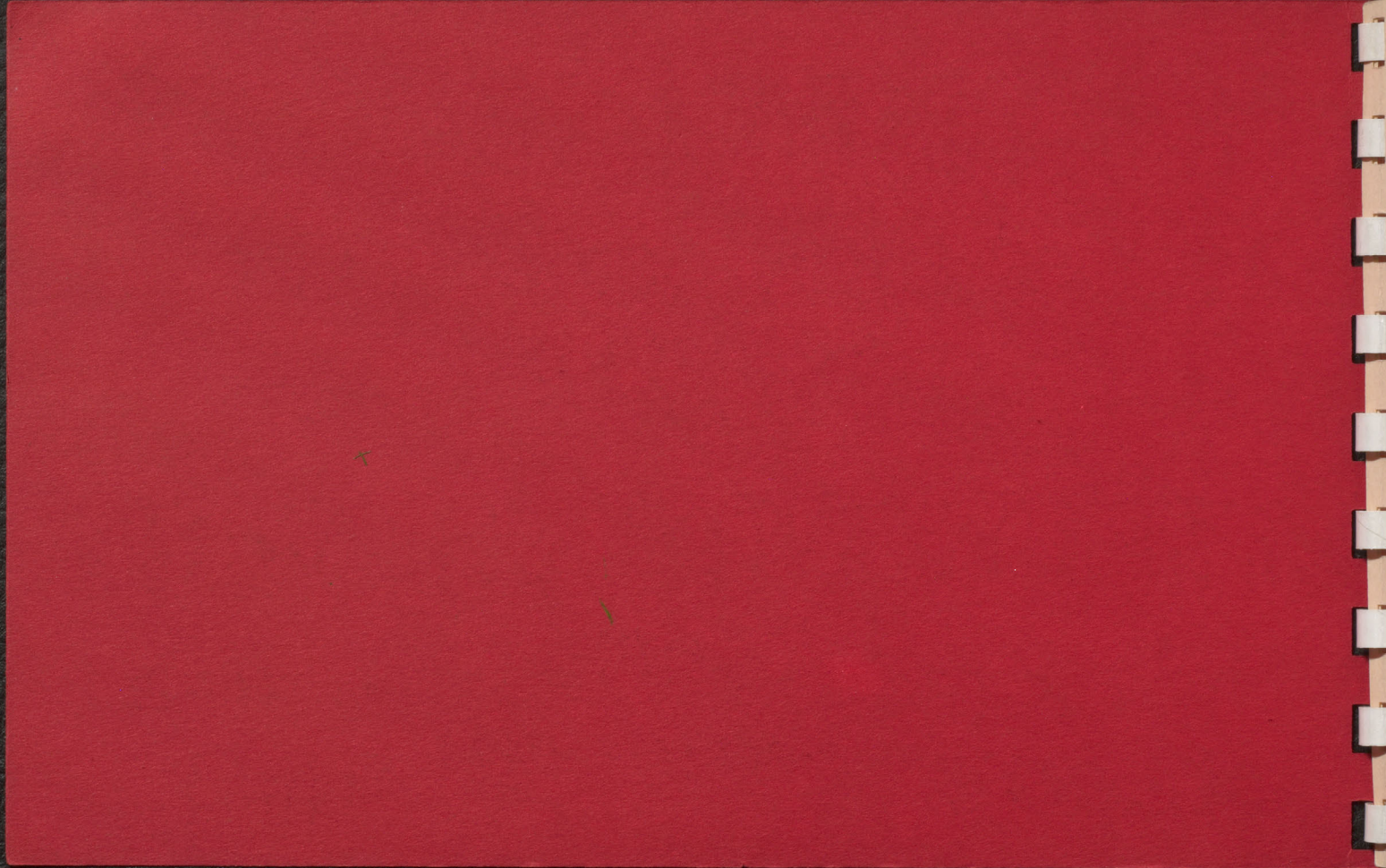

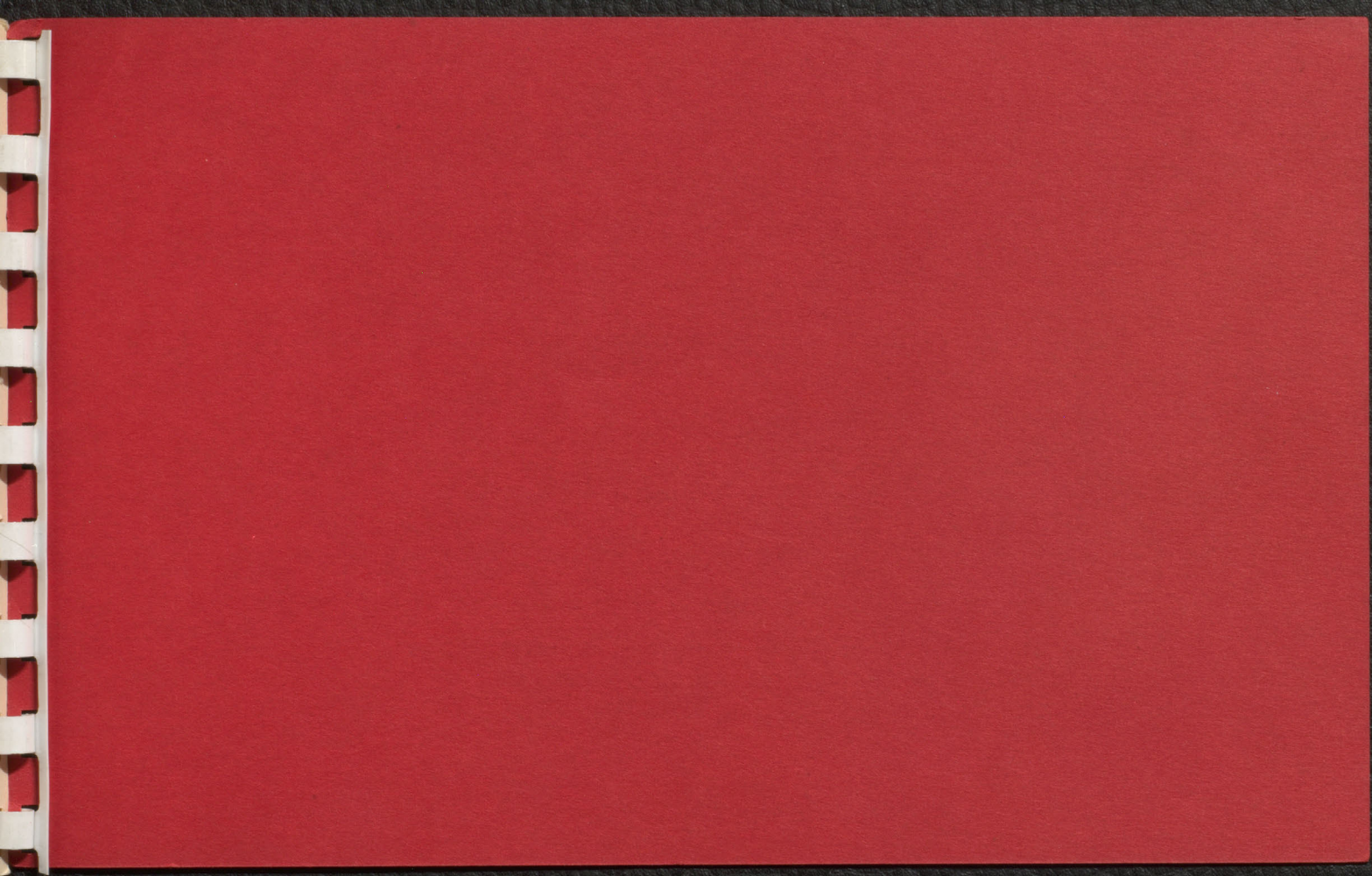
In 1922, the Bronze Baby was donated to the Women's Intercollegiate Basketball League by the Students' Council of McGill University. It is a replica of a large statue in the grounds of Dunfermline College of Physical Education in Scotland.

The first year after its christening the University of Toronto took possession of it. The following year it was won by McGill.

Queen's, Toronto and McGill Universities constituted the Intercollegiate League until 1928, when the University of Western Ontario was included. In 1940, Western won the championship and the Bronze Baby remained in London throughout the war years while competition was at a standstill.

Since the war the winners of the Bronze Baby and the places of competition were as follows:

- 1946 - McGill University at Montreal
- 1947 - University of Toronto at London
- 1948 - Queen's University at Kingston
- 1949 - University of Toronto at Toronto
