October 13, 1932. E. W. Beatty, Esq., K.C., LL.D., Chancellor, McGill University My dear Chancellor, I am attaching herewith a copy of a letter addressed to Mr. Taschereau last august. You will note from it that we have not yet received any of the grants for the University year 1931-32. Not only does the dilatoriness of the Province greatly embarrass us, but we are suffering in a financial way as well. Furthermore, the grants for our year 1932-33 are now due, and again we are inconvenienced. I have had no reply from Mr. Taschereau to my letter, and respectfully suggest that you see what you can do. August Twenty-third 1932. Honourable L. A. Taschereau, K.C., Prime Minister, Province of Quebec, P.Q. My dear Mr. Taschereau: I regret very much having to trouble you in regard to the payment of the following grants to the University for the school year 1931-1932, but my excuse for doing so must be that the matter, from the University's point of view, is somewhat serious. The grants to which I refer and on which nothing has been paid are,-1. To the School for Teachers at Macdonald College and our Department of Education \$ 25,000. To the School of Commerce 7.000. 3. To McGill University, general funds 25,000. \$ 57,000. For the school year 1930-1931 the grant for the School for Teachers and our Department of Education was paid on December 16th, 1930; the grant for the School of Commerce was paid on June 18th, 1931, and the grant to McGill University, general funds, was paid on June 19th, 1931. I give you these dates in order that you may see how much overdue the payments on account of these grants are for the school year 1931-1932. I might add that apart from everything else we are losing interest on this very considerable sum of money. May I bespeak your good offices to secure an early payment of these grants. I am.
