Memo for Dr. Chesney

Thayer, "Osler and other papers", 1931, p. 21, mentions "the little silver-clasped volume" which is to be opened for the 100th anniversary of the opening of the J. H. H. (not, as T. says of Osler's death). It is bound in black cloth with leather back, lettered "Notes, Johns Hopkins Hospital. Personal", 24.5 x 16.5 cm.; the lock broken, but the vol. sealed in red tape since last opened in 1928.

W. O. left it far from completed, and used the blanks for other notes having nothing to do with the J. H. H., so it will be kept under lock and key in the Osler Library, and entered in its card catalogue.
