Very many thanks for your letter of the 18th. in regard to the suggestion made by Dr. Hector Munro that Wenkebach should come to England.

I have been making enquiries, and am told by the Home Office that if Professor Wenkebach applies to the <sup>British</sup> military authorities at Vienna (where I understand he now is?) for a visa he should have no difficulty about coming over here, as he is a Dutchman. If any difficulty should arise, I hope you will let me know, because I think it would be very desirable for Wenkebach to come over to this country.
