He takes the 9:50 for London due at Charing Cross at 5:12. I have written him care Mrs. McCagg, Palace Hotel, Rome. I will yield him to you for Saturday, although I don't want to a bit for I feel as though I couldn't wait another day to see him. I do not know whether his train goes from the <sup>Paris</sup> ~~San~~ du Nord, or from the <sup>Paris</sup> ~~San~~ de Lyons when it arrives. I hope Mrs. Jacobs is better today. This is a glorious day here and one yearns to work in the garden - at least I do - I am rushing this off so you'll get it in the morning.
