Dear Lafleur:-

Mrs. Hart has improved very much evidently. The gastroptosis is better, and while she complains a great deal of dragging pain in the side, there is evidently decreasing discomfort. She has been worried and apprehensive about the possibility of a third operation on her stomach, but I told her I did not think that would be necessary. I think the pylorus is palpable; at any rate there was a movable body just between the navel and the ensiform, which felt like it. I have urged her to take more food, to live out of doors, and to keep her mind out of her bread-basket.

This you will find on your return. Welcome home. I hope you have had a good trip.
