which I have overlooked in
Osler's note book — especially the
Parisian lectures — and so with
Osler's consent I am
sending it with these sheets —
I find the notes occasionally
difficult to decipher —

The German itinerary
I have been able to make

definite, from letters to my
wife at Lausanne which she
had kept. These naturally
ceased when she joined us,
otherwise I might have been
able to furnish further
particulars of our visit to
Paris.

Was Kükler at Würzburg
or Munich in 1890? I have
made him at Würzburg —
better have that looked up
say from the Text book,
which I cannot do here.

Please alter the enclosed
sheets in any way you think
fit. The Paris lectures showed
little you to decide whether
they had any influence on
Oster.

We return to Oxford
