Dr. Osler is up in Edinburgh." I have no recollection as to what he was doing in Edinburgh. My letter was written from Newcastle on my way north and I was in Edinburgh later but have no recollection of seeing W. O. there.

One of our men from here, named Burgess Gordon, has received an appointment under Christian. If you come across him I wish you would give him a cheering word. He is a very nice boy even if he has a red head, and I hope he is going to do well up there.
