Dear Sir

The material used for inoculation is manufactured solely from cultures in the laboratory. On the whole I am in favour of compulsory inoculation for the soldiers. I recognize that there is a difficulty in the introducing such a measure into this country. So far I do not think there has been any serious difficulty in inducing the men to consent.
