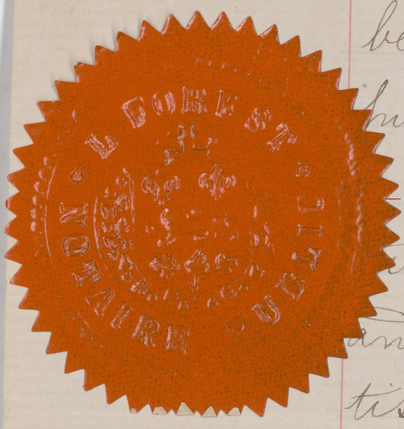
Who declared unto us, said Notary, as follows:—

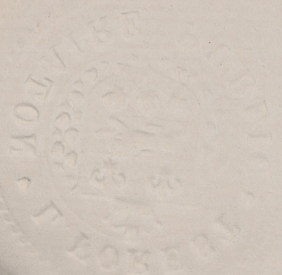

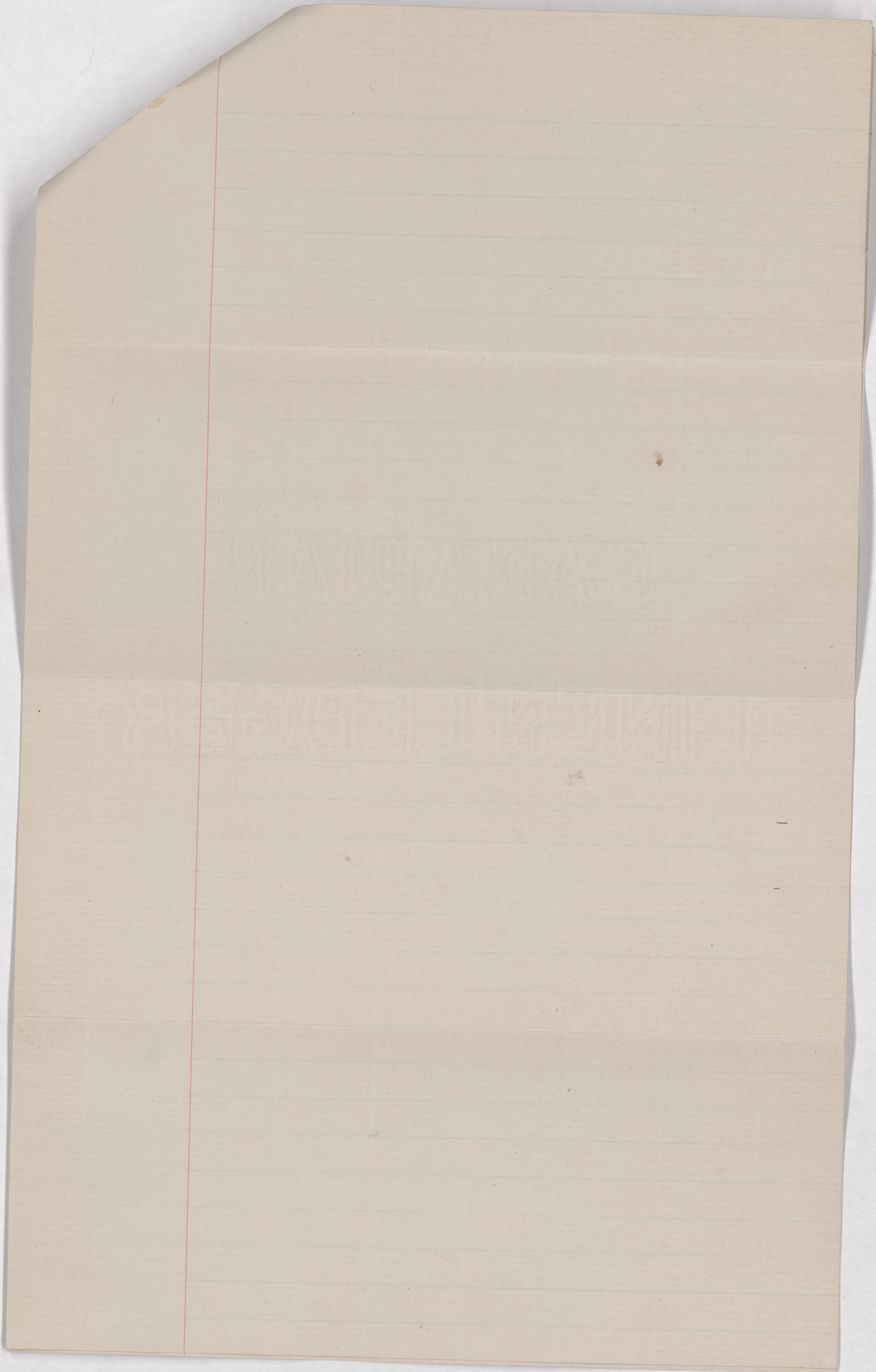
