Sir

In obedience to His Excellency's commands conveyed by you on the 22^d Oct^r I have been preparing a final statement of the accounts regarding the communications of International communications for this country - But that statement is not ready although nearly so - owing principally to unsettled claims and scattered vouchers which give some trouble to collect - And as it is proper that these Returns should be made as correct and satisfactory as possible - and as the the papers respecting them - from litigious causes, happen to be rather bulky and of a nature that may require some explanation I would beg, of His Excellency's further indulgence to the meeting of Parliament, when I shall have the pleasure of being the bearer myself - and which please submit to His Excellency Sir James Kempton.
