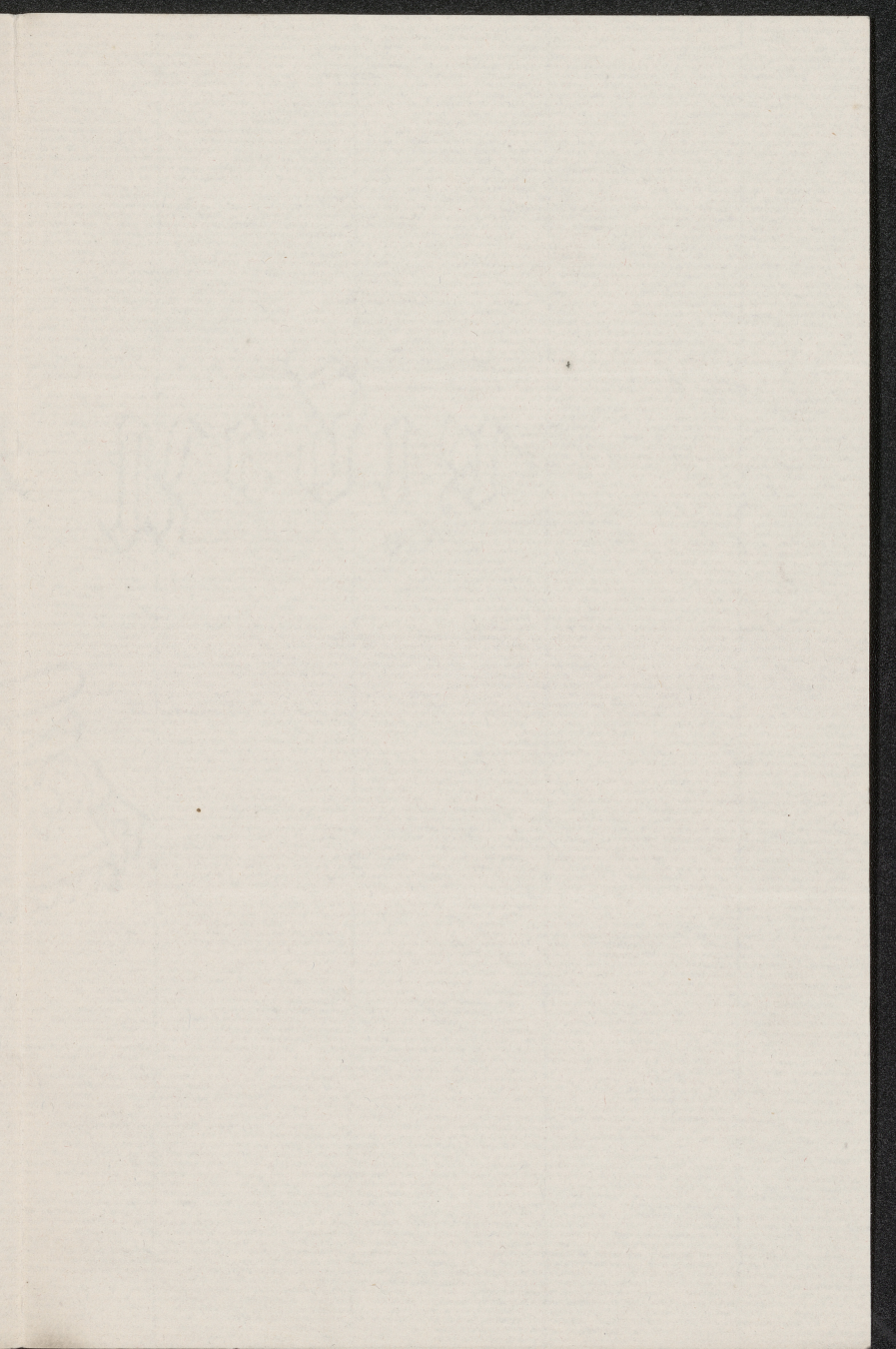
Dear Noel,
