Lady Gwillim was the wife of Sir Henry Gwillim, a Justice of the Supreme  
Court of Madras, 1801-1807. She died in ~~1806~~ 1807, aged 44, and was  
buried in St. Mary's Church, Fort St. George, Madras.

So far as known, she was the first artist of im-  
portance to portray the larger birds life-  
size, thus antedating Audubon by a  
generation. - C.A.W.
