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THIS INDENTURE, Made the Third day of October in the

of the one part, and James Dawson, also of Pictou. Bookseller

of the other part, WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred & fourty
Pounds lawful money of Nova Scotia to him in hand paid by the said James Dawson

at or before the ensealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, he the said Robert Gaff hath

granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released and confirmed, and by these Presents, doth grant, bargain, sell,
alien, enfeoff, release and confirm, unto him the said James Dawson his

Heirs and Assigns, all that certain tract, piece or Parcel of Land
Situate, lying and being, Near the Town Gut of Pictou
aforesaid, and is abutted and bounded as follows.
That is to say, on the West by a Lot of Land occupied
by one Thomas Meagher; on the South, by the old
High Way leading from Pictou towards Halifax; on
the East by Lands owned by the Heirs of the Late
David Pagan Patterson, and on the North by the
New Road leading from Pictou to the Town Gut
Bridge, so called, containing Eighteen Acres, be
the same more or less.

together with all and singular, the Houses, Outhouses, Buildings, Ways, Watercourses, Privileges, Appendages, and Appurte-
nances, to the said Tract or Parcel of Land belonging, or in any wise appertaining, with the reversion and reversions; remainder and remainders,
rents, issues, and profits thereof, and all the Estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever which the said Robert Gaff
at any time

had or may have, in or to the same. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract, Piece and Parcel of Land above described, together
with all and singular the Appurtenances unto him the said James Dawson his

Heirs and Assigns, and to his & their only use, benefit and behoof forever. And the said Robert Gaff
for himself, his Heirs, Executors and Administrators

Doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with the said James Dawson his

Heirs and Assigns in manner and form following: That is to say—that he the said Robert Gaff hath
a good and sufficient Deed in fee simple and has
good right, lawful authority, and absolute power in himself to grant, alien and convey the said Tract or Parcel of Land above described
with all and singular the Appurtenances, in manner and form as before granted, and conveyed; that he the said James Dawson

and his Heirs and Assigns, shall and may, at all times hereafter, peaceably
and quietly, have, hold, occupy, possess and enjoy the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances and every part and parcel thereof, without any
manner, of let, trouble, eviction, hindrance, or molestation whatsoever, of or from the said Robert Gaff

or any person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same,
or any part thereof, and Isobella, wife of the said Robert Gaff

in token of her Release and Relinquishment of Dower
to the before described premises, hath hereunto set her
hand and affixed her Seal.
