Lloyd's 3<sup>rd</sup> April 1841.

Sir,

I beg to acquaint you that I have received and laid before the Committee for managing the Affairs of Lloyd's, your letter of the 12<sup>th</sup> Inst. relative to your inspecting Vessels during their progress in building, to enable you to give a Certificate of their true character, and I am directed to inform you that the surveying of Ships is under a different Committee, but that no Surveyors are appointed out of the United Kingdom - at the same time to observe that it is no part of your duty as Agent for this Establishment, to superintend while Vessels are building, unless specially called upon so to do, by the parties immediately concerned.
