Mr James McDonald

Sir

If you should at any time hereafter erect a Wooden Building on the Lot you have bought from me on Water Street, of the same height, Width & Pitch of Roof as my Building which adjoins your Lot on the West - please to allow me to ~~connect~~ ^{lath} and otherwise finish on the East End of said Building and will remove the Clapboards and Windows, or propose to let you do so, and will allow you to make any other necessary fixture, in order to enable you to connect your Frame substantially with mine.
