And we make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of an act made and passed in the Sixth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the fourth intituled "An Act to repeal an Act of the present Session of Parliament intituled An Act for the more effectual abolition of Oaths and affirmations taken and made in various departments of the State and

to substitute declarations in lieu thereof and for the more entire suppression
of voluntary and extrajudicial Oaths and affidavits and to make other
provisions for the abolition of unnecessary Oaths
