

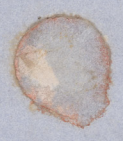

Wesley 30th July 1850.

Dear Sir

I received your note of the 11<sup>th</sup> Inst. Respecting the bibles and other books received. I have enclosed 20/- from which I wish you to take 6/3 for your own account and for 2 vols. Ed. P. Mothers and the balance 13/9 is what I have received or expect to receive from the bibles and testament as near as I can tell. I had to give some away gratis and credit other which I did rather of necessity than choice.

As I understand your son the present Editor of the Register is at Halifax and you are expected to attend a little to his duties in his absence, including the first no. Will you please to have a copy directed and forwarded by mail, via "Holly" to "Mr. J. W. P. Chisholm, Wallace River," and mark it in the books if you have them, paid to me. Please also to have the following sums received by me acknowledged in the July no. of the Register if practicable. From Nine Mile River £7 for Mission Boats, from Chebucto £3 and 10/- in addition to a former sum for Mission Boats and £5 from Ladies Miss. Soc. to Amagouche for Foreign Missions.
