Welsh's Sermons Vol II, was published by Subscription and was not to be had the last time we applied for it, but we have written to Inverness, as we stated before, and have not received any reply yet. You are aware there are very few New Gaelic Books, - they are mostly Reprints of Standard Books translated. We are happy to learn the School Books are gaining ground with your efforts, and in reference to the terms, we have very little profit, when we allow you 5% from the Invoice. - all others we charge them net. The terms however are very liberal, and we have no doubt you will find we are cheaper than our Neighbours.
