Dear Sir

Yours of the 30th
April came to hand

We could print the
Harmonicon in 8^o as
the 3^d Edition is printed
for £23..13..4 (H Cy)
including the title page, ^{cover} and
back which would have
to be set up. If you
had paper large ^{enough} to put
12 pages on the press
we could get it done
for

£19. and would return
it to you free of expense
finding at ~~50~~ fifty shillings
per 100. We are about
clearing every thing out
of the Old Establishment
and I expect to come
across some of the Gaelic
Manuals and odd sheets
which I will send you
yours completed and let
you know how many
we have

The Board of Education
here want me to get up
a history and Geography

which would relate
more particularly to the
Provinces than those in
common use, would
not William undertake
to get one up, or to extend
his little book just published
so as to fit it as well to the
schools in this Island
as Nova Scotia. I have
a Lithographic Press
going, and will send
you some specimens as
soon as I get a little
more practice. With
it we could do some
rough maps.

I am getting a Map of
P.E. I Lithographed in Edinburgh
3 feet long and expect it out
the middle of June, if you
hear any enquiry for it, you
can say one is preparing.
Sir Alex Bannerman is going to
help us with it.

If William has a Report
of his Educational tour I
should be glad to see it
and you might send a
few catalogues of seeds
I will disperse them and
take orders. I have two
Harmonicons left which
I dare say will soon sell
