



Memorandum of an agreement
made and entered into by James Dawson
Bookseller of Pictou, and Geo T Hazard
of Charlottetown.

The said Geo T Hazard hereby
agrees to print for the said James
Dawson, an edition of one thousand copies
of the Harmonicon, Music Book, 272 pages
with printed cover, and to bind the same
in a like manner as the third edition of
that work published by James Dawson,
The said James Dawson furnishing the
stereotype plates, and paper for the same,
(sufficiently large to print 16 pages at
one time), and the said Geo T Hazard
binding all other requisite materials
In consideration of which
services in a workmanlike manner
to be performed the said James
Dawson

Dawson, hereby agrees to pay the
said George Hazard, the sum of Ten
Pounds three shillings and nine pence
Halifax Currency for every 250 Copies
of the work ~~so~~ done as aforesaid.

And it is further agreed between the said
parties that the said James Dawson shall pay
the freight of the said paper and stereotype plates
going and returning and of finished Books
and the same shall be at his risk while on
Board of the Vessel conveying the same.

And the said Geo Hazard hereby engages that
he will not print for his own use or sale, or suffer
to be printed by any other person, any other
Copies of the said work from said plates while
in his possession, save and except those for the said
James Dawson. And the said Geo Hazard
further engages to take all due care of said plates
while the same are being printed from, and to
have them properly cleaned and repacked
and laden on board ship for their return home.
