Boston March 14<sup>th</sup> 1836

I cannot say how soon the second volume of the Family Bible will be issued. Dr. Edwards, who was preparing the notes, died while completing the 9<sup>th</sup> Psalm, having previously finished the New Testament. It has been very difficult to find any one to continue the work in the plan originally adopted, but it is now in progress and I am in hopes will be issued in the course of this year.

The 1<sup>st</sup> volume sells well; but the Testament & Psalms bound by themselves are having an unprecedented sale. Over 150,000 have already been issued.
