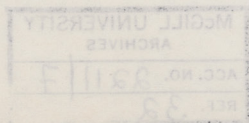

Boston April 1st 1836
Messrs J. Dawson & Son,
Gents

Enclosed please
find invoice of Goods, which
we shall forward, per first
Packet, direct to Pictou & send
you bill of Lading, when we
ship Goods, from Havre, we
will also send, soon as Rec^d
As regards the Charge on the
Goods, from Montreal, We only
charged you exactly, what
we were obliged to pay out.
The Goods, were in Bond, &
if we had shipped them to
you, as in Bond, without
paying the Charges, they tell us
have, that it would have
Cost you \$3 more. We enclose
one of the bills, that was paid
out at Portland, by the agt of
the Steamer. We are newly from

that you think you have been
imposed upon. We are perhaps
a little green, in managing Custom
House Matters, as we have no
experience, with them. We
kept one of our Men going
to & from the Custom House,
Stone House, Steamer &c. ~~the~~
best part of three days, before
we could get your box.
If you are satisfied, that
we have been, imposed upon,
by the Custom House Officers,
on account of our greenness,
we are perfectly willing, that
you should, change back
to us, all that we have
changed you, & next time
we will know, better
how to proceed
