Jas Murchock Esq

Dr Sir

We were informed one day last week by a Person, in whose <sup>we</sup> word <sup>we</sup> think we can place Confidence - that, Some time ago, a Box came up with the Coach, as far as Mr Snaser's West River, & addressed to us, that in Shipton it ran our Coach to another it was put by mistake into the wrong Coach, and went on to the Eastward - that some days thereafter it came back to Frasero, where it has been lying a considerable length of time, and is yet there; We asked our Informant to wait that night at the Stable, and remind the Coachmen to bring it, which we have reason to believe he did - yet it has not come forward.

If our information be true, we should think we have just Grounds of Complaint at the Carelessness of your servants to our interests.

We have mentioned the above just as we got it in order, that you may make judicious inquiry into it.
