for Curry. They will be sent next opportunity.
Messrs Burs & Harris Agents for the "Cordelia"
decline doing anything about your goods
they say that the vessel has sailed and
consequently have no further control of
her! We had to unpack the Room papers
in new boxes. as the old ones were entirely
useless.
