

Amherst 3<sup>rd</sup> Nov 1856

Sir

On receipt of yours of the 9<sup>th</sup> ult I immediately  
sent my self in communication Mr Ratchford & Lewis Sinks (the  
late Deputy Surveyor for the Township of Parrsboro) and I now  
enclose you Mr Ratchfords Certificate of Registers of Alexander Le  
Scribe Deed to Wm Tate also of S<sup>rd</sup> Tate & Wm Tate to James Dawson  
I also enclose you Mr Ratchfords Letter to me - As I enclosed  
your first letter to me - immediately to Mr Ratchford - My memory  
does not now serve me whether he is correct in the first  
Paragraph of his letter to me in reference to overlooking Scribes  
Deed to Tate -

I also enclose you Mr Lewis Sinks Memorandum  
& Sketch which will speak for it self - I may observe that  
before writing to Mr Sinks I came to the conclusion that  
the Surveyor General himself is the proper person to give  
the Certificate respecting the larger grant of Willm enclosing the  
smaller grant (if it really does) of Lamb & Tate, as he holds the  
return Plans of the whole Township of Parrsboro (which I do  
not) Besides the Surveyor <sup>General</sup> can have access to the  
Records of both those grants, the descriptions of which  
will show whether they interfere one with the other

I will see Mr Sinks in a short time and if I  
can obtain any further information in the matter I will readily  
communicate it

You will see what Mr Ratchford says in the  
matter of fees - you can forward the amount in Post Stamps  
to me, and I will pay Mr Ratchfords Brother in Amherst as  
requested
