Nov 5th 1836

Dear Sir

I was unable to answer
your letter by last mail
Mr Owen did not arrive until
very late on Monday night.

The first I heard of
the parcel you speak of was

forward it. The coach leaving
their place ^{twice} a week, I told

the Harmonicons and will

over

of our goods in good order
the remainder I expect
yet to come will be damaged
Can you tell me whether
Cowans insure at Lloyd's or
not

Please send me a Nova
Scotia almanack as soon as
you get one
