

Martha Jane 19th 1857

Dear Sir

I rec^d yours and plead guilty to my neglect tho in some degree unintentional I have been for more than three years in a very bad state of health much reduced in body and mind -

My daughters were forced to give up the school here from the opposition of a Party - and went to Canada where my Youngest daughter was taken ill while attending the Normal School in Toronto and has not been able to take a school until this Autumn she is now in Cleveland Ohio where she has been for more than two years most of the time when able she has been employed by one of the judges and some members of the Bar

At present I am unable to meet your demand but hope in about six

wishes to remit you the amount

I may here state that a considerable
sum was owing to my daughter when they
left not one farthing of which has been
collected by the Trustees or otherwise
