James Danson Esq
Dear Sir,

I am just favored
with yours of the 12th Inst.
Before receiving this, you
will have been apprised by
my letter of the shipment
of your things for Sch^r "Abeille"
Cap^t Arbour,

The vessel left here
2 or 3 days ago, intending to
call at Bedeque for oysters,
on his way to Montreal.
The vessel being a constant
trader between Montreal -
Quebec - Magdalen Islands &
lower ports, will be well
known to your insurance

Companies, so that if you
wish insurance effected, you
will get it done more readily
in Canada, than in Halifax.

I leave the matter of insurance
in your hands; as your letter
^{only} asks me to have them insu-
red from Halifax

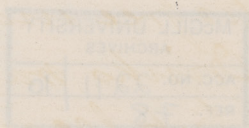
