This is a sanatorium or whatever you call the things, and they treat you most carefully. The grub and dining-



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room maids and things generally are the best yet; but it costs \$3⁰⁰ a day so I'm afraid to do much loafing here.

I hope the world continues to treat you well. It seems a long time since I heard from you last.

I met a cousin of Jeanne Kennedy last night and had dinner with him.

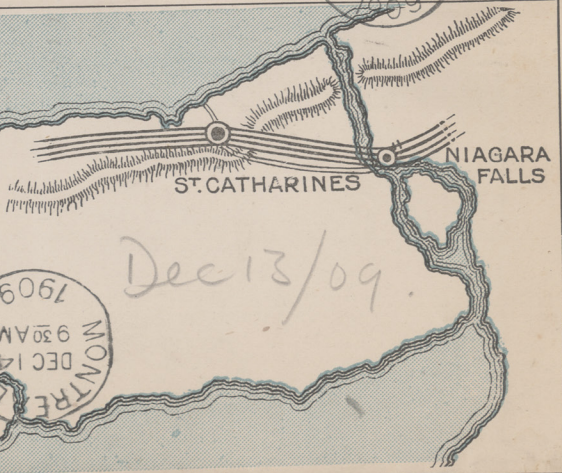
