the replics are set in caps at the.

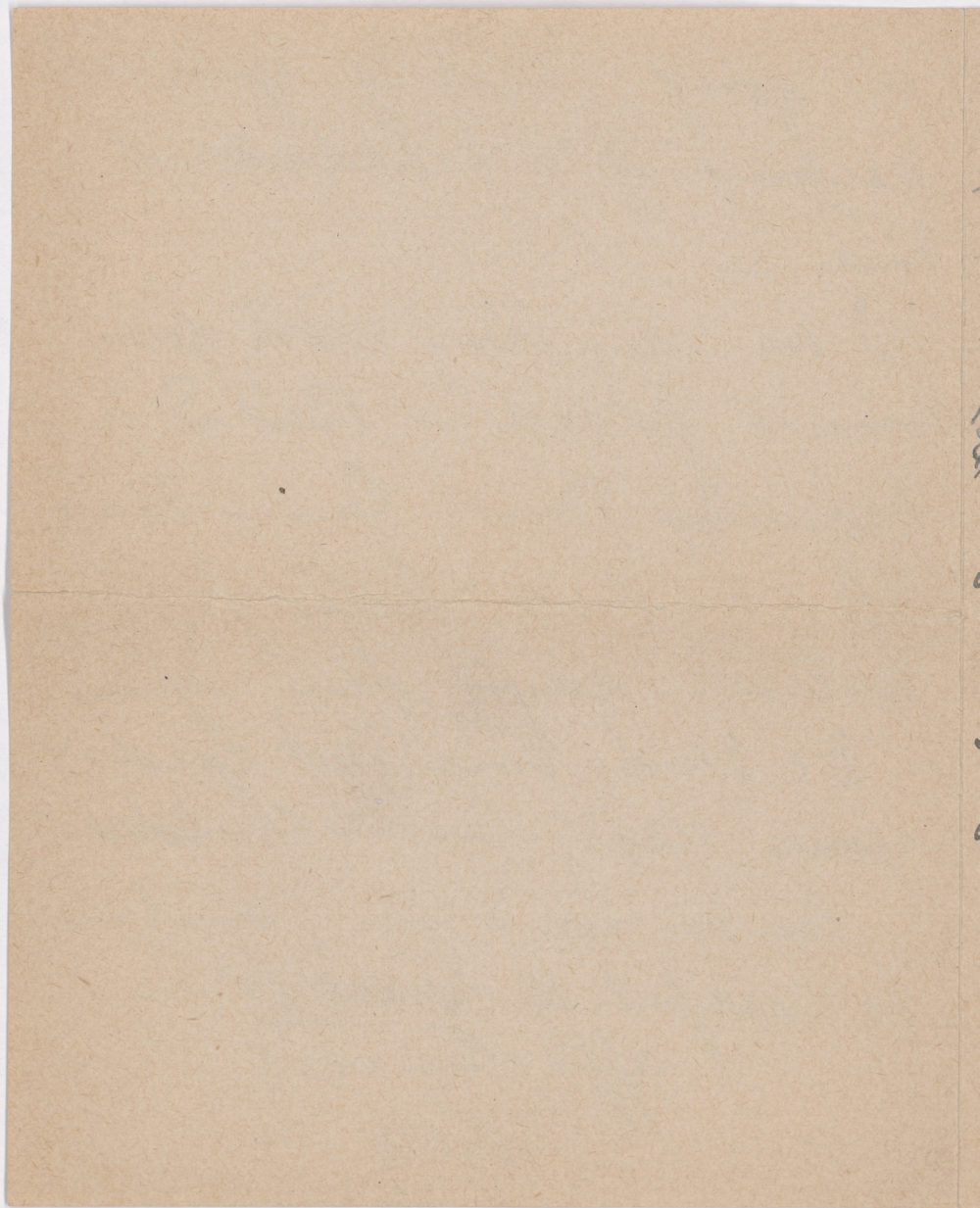
Poor fellow was so ugly, that I fear he had not much of a chance with me . . . !!!

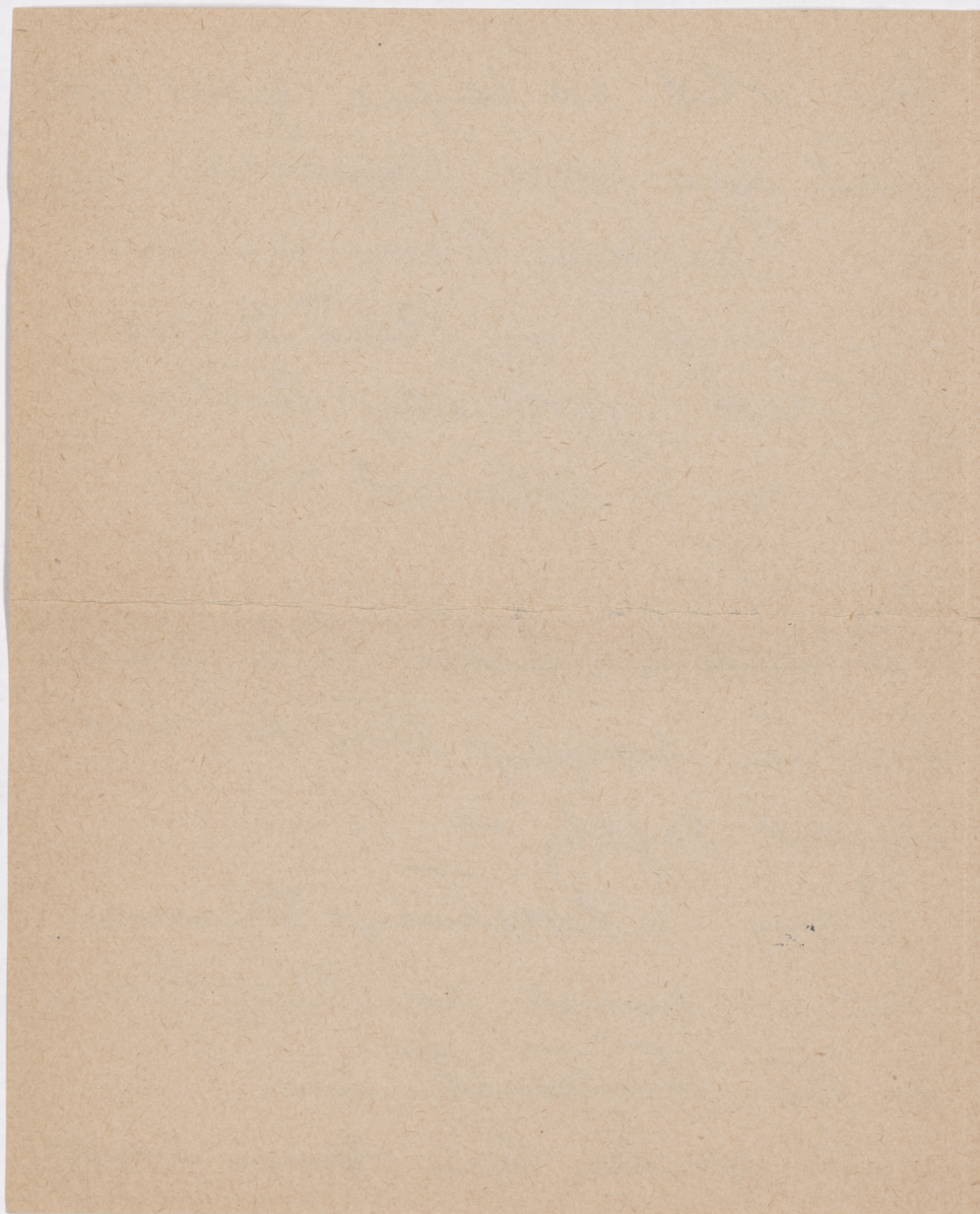
