now, excuse the scrawl

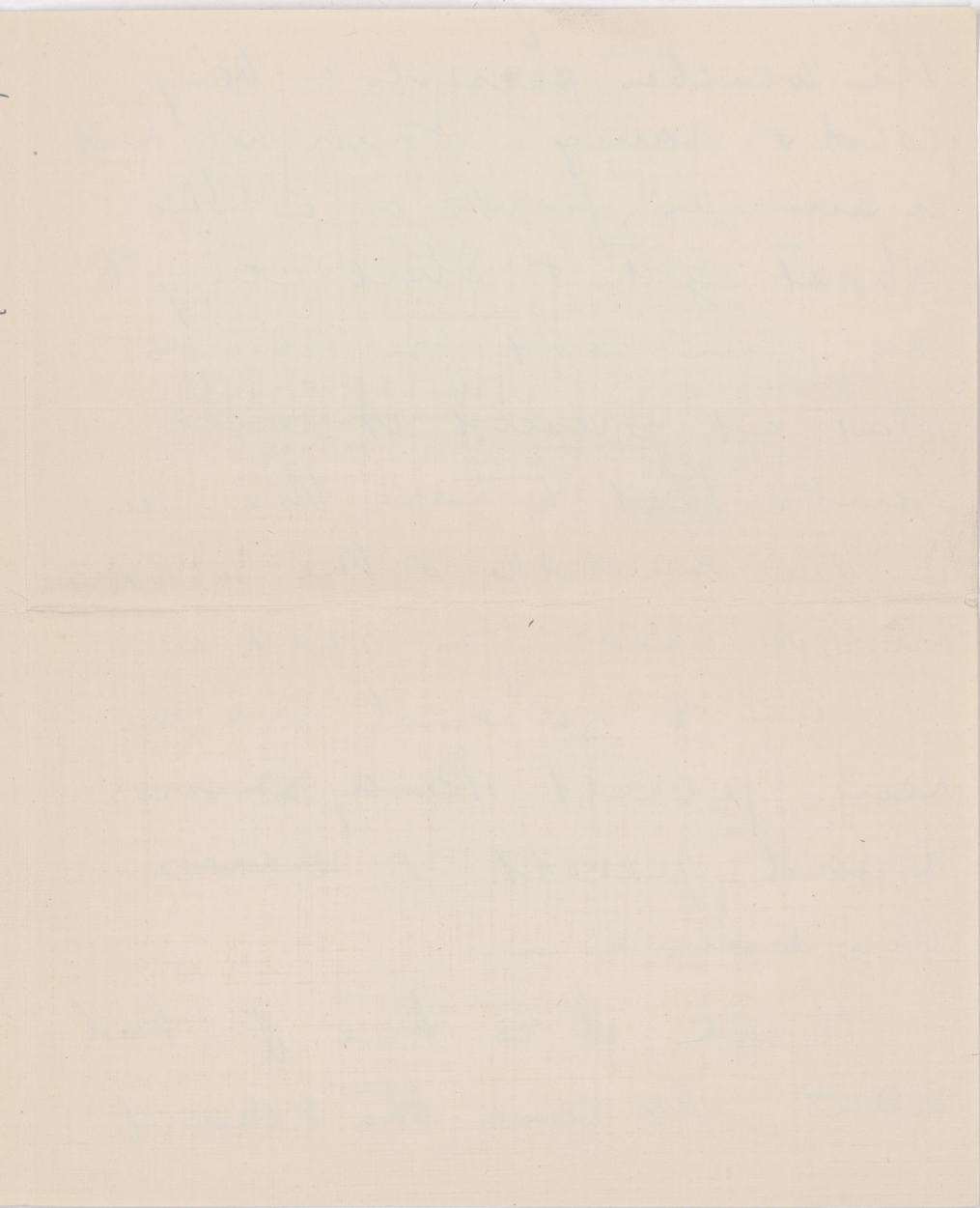
