The composing is less than the estimate in consequence of an error which the printers had made in the calculation & we have made a small deduction on the paper. When we received your letter with a small addition for the Maps, the printing was finished and we therefore did not get it added. The Map of a Note is usually placed <sup>at the</sup> end, as it does not <sup>so much</sup> improve the book, <sup>by the marks</sup> which it leaves on the title page and we have therefore placed it there.

The amount of the whole we have charged to Messrs. Dawson & Son & we will allow 5 per cent discount on the amount remitted in account thereof, & if you prefer sending the balance shortly it will be subject to the same abate. The copies we retained we will later in like manner to your price, but of course both there and the account can be transferred
