I have to acknowledge

Chiniquy is very much
encouraged - constant
accessions to his church
from Rome -
on Sunday last I was
at Pointe aux Trembles -
Twenty one of the pupils
have given good evidence

of their conversion to X^t,
and twenty of these par-
took of the Lord's Supper.
For weeks past the male
pupils ^{of the above} have met daily
of their own accord, for
prayer for God's blessing.

You are about to leave
us for a time - I often
wish that my work brought
me more in contact with
you & yours, that I have
I might have the benefit
of a more frequent inter-
course. I sincerely trust
that the change & rest
may recruit all your
