


Fallowfield

sections of Calamites that
would almost fill even
you with envy. I have
got magnificent medullary
rays even in the type
with pseudo-scalaniform
vesels - They are all

are set on end. 
Further I have ascer-

that the cells of the larger
trunks separating the woody
wedges have largely pre-
dominant in them, the
same mural arrange-
ment so that they are
nothing less than large
medullary rays, separating
woody wedges - as the
smaller ones separate
