My dear Dr. Dawson

Thursday will suit us
quite well : if you will kindly let me
know by what train you think of coming
I will try to meet you : if by any chance
I fail to do so, please drive to Clevedon House,
Park Town. We dine at seven.

Dr. Rolleston met me just now &
asked me to ask you whether you could

conveniently dine with him on Monday the
13th - as in anticipation of your coming
he had asked some friends to meet you on
that day. If that day, however, would be
inconvenient to you, please let me know
by return, in order that another arrangement
may be made.

I hope that you are prepared to
find me very busy: but although I shall
have to leave you for several hours in

the day, I shall not be afraid of your finding
time hang very heavily on your hands as
long as you have the Museum & the Bodleian
at your disposal.
