characteristics of the
species, and I would

your collector in the
list I am now getting
up, for any information
the specimens may
be.

I hope to be in New
York next summer, and
may perhaps have a
few days in July.
Please inform me if
you do any dredging
or expect to do so
next summer, and
if you have good
sedges or
quids with all kind
