My dear Sir

Your tel. of 25th Inst is rec^d and letter of 22nd Inst we await the offer to be rec^d by mail which we shall answer immediately by tel.

Batterys Hill is about 5 miles on toward Innes from Glengarry Station on the line of Railway. A line drawn from thence to the centre of the Area at the West side of the East River on which the speculation as described by Hartley is found would pass immediately through Glengarry Station. I have therefore taken two areas having that line as a centre leading from Glengarry Eastwardly say East 9° South, and one Area Westwardly from Glengarry in the same direction. I have also taken a ~~third~~^{second} claim on the Area containing the specular ore at East River. Carmichael having got before us with the five miles surrounding it. If the parties with whom our firm is interested as holding two areas where the ore is known to exist can be got to sell reasonably there is now

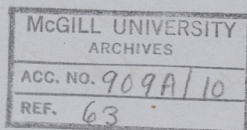
sufficient territory covered to serve
