1872

My Dear Dr Dawson -

I received your letter
last evening - If necessary I
will be in Montreal on the
26th but I had intended going
to the convocation of the college
at Lunenburg on that day
- I have been invited for a

gone - and feel that I ought

to go. If the 27th would do
in Montreal I could be
there at two o'clock and
remain as long as might
be necessary - Please write
me (or telegraph) about it
for if it be important that
I should be there on the

courtesies go - as a mere
matter of preference I would
certainly rather be in
Montreal than Lennoxville
- If I do not go to the latter
place

I can be with you on
the 25th without inconvenience
