My dear Sir,

I am not sure whether
I ever answered your letter to me
of Jan 26th which I have now
before me.

The Science Commission has
had under review the primary
science teaching in the Country,
but we have not as yet made
any report regarding the higher
science teaching. We are now
taking evidence as to the

advances made of Science, and
have yet to report on that
and the higher science teaching.

We have not yet fully discussed
these subjects, indeed as a
body we have done nothing
yet in these points beyond
taking evidence. This has
yet to be reported and
discussed, which it pretty
certainly will not be before
we break up for the vacation.

The discription will hardly
close on before the close
of the year.
